

PUSH COFFEE MAKER FURNITURE/LIGHTING/ACCESSORIES

Mette Duedahl on the design "PUSH puts a new perspective on coffee making - pushing the drinking of coffee to a higher level. The soft and pleasant feel of the stoneware is reflected in the rounded, smooth shape of the jug. I wanted to make a coffee press, which is both soft to look at and soft to hold. The friendly shape goes hand in hand with the warm and cozy atmosphere that a good cup of coffee provides. PUSH is s characteristic coffee press with a contemporary Nordic design."

PROCESS

Clay mass is poured into a mold, dried, hand processed and finally burned. The jug is glazed on the inside, while the raw stone is kept on the outside.

The Push coffee maker has a contemporary design, yet with warm and rounded shapes. Use the jug for it's original purpose of making coffee or take out the plunger unit and use the jug for serving water or other beverages.

The jug is made of stoneware. Plunger unit is made of steel and the lid is made of plastic. Comes with a beech wood knob and a rubber

Dishwasher safe, except for wooden knob. Separate all elements before cleaning.
